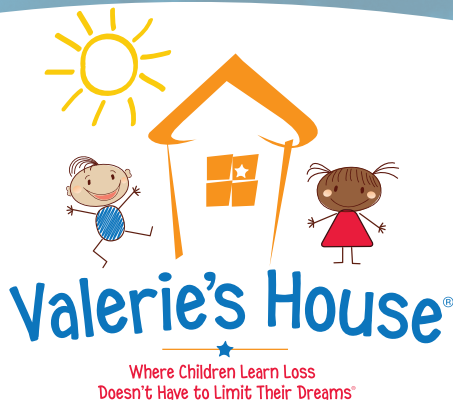


# Become a Valerie's House Dinner Sponsor
